

Two routes to achieving your UK Bachelor's Degree

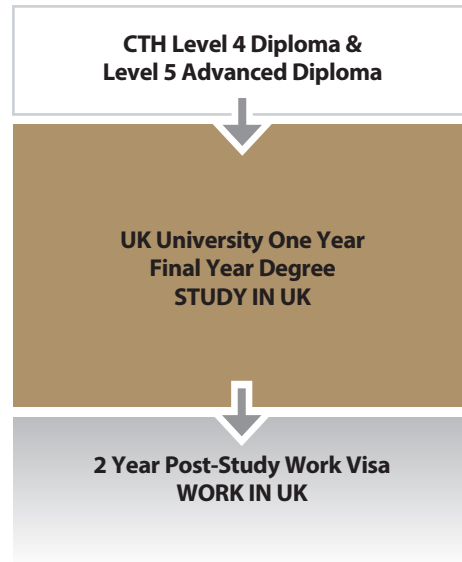
ROUTE ONE

Progress to a university in the UK to study for a 1 year Top-Up Degree...

Students who successfully complete the CTH Level 5 Advanced Diploma (and especially those that have also first completed the CTH Level 4 Diploma) have a wide choice of universities to choose from in the UK to complete a FINAL YEAR Bachelor's Degree in hospitality or tourism management.

...and then work in the UK

International students who start their studies in the UK in 2020 or after will then benefit from the new post-study work visa for graduates. This usually means a work and residence permit of 2 years after graduation. A wonderful opportunity to launch your career in a world-leading business environment!



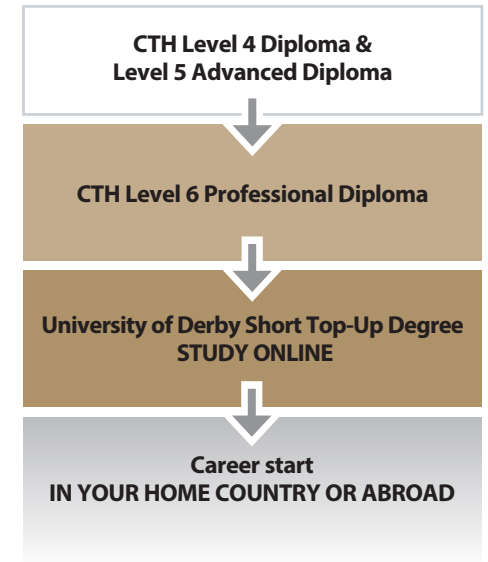
ROUTE TWO

Progress to further study without leaving your home country...

Students who successfully complete the CTH Level 5 Advanced Diploma can choose to continue their studies in their home country by stepping up to study the next level CTH programme. The Level 6 Professional Diploma in Tourism & Hospitality Management offers 120 study credits (equivalent to a UK university bachelor's degree Final Year) and provides valuable skills for your future career.

...and go on to achieve CTH Level 6 and a University of Derby Degree

Students who successfully complete the Level 6 are exempted from 3 of the 6 units of the University of Derby Final Year, the absolute maximum level of exemptions allowed by the University's rules for the award of one of its degrees. What is more, the University offers students the opportunity to study this programme **ONLINE**, allowing students to complete their UK university Bachelor's Degree wherever they are based around the world.
